



DSL-2750U Storage Setup



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


- Plug the 3-Pin Power Supply/ Lightning Protection unit into the wall outlet and then connect the other end of it (12VDC IN)

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- **Connect the Ethernet LAN Cable to any (yellow) port on the Router and connect the other end to the LAN port of the PC**


CONNECTING TO THE UNIT VIA WEB GUI



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How to login to Unit using the Web GUI

1. Go to your Internet Explorer or Default Browser.
2. In your URL field, type the **Default IP (10.0.0.2) of router.**
3. A login page will appear and you will be prompted for a **Username and Password** these are both **“admin”**

Setting up a USB external hard drive or flash drive as a shared storage facility.



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
Notes:

- *FAT 32 devices are limited to 32GB maximum and the file can't be greater than 4GB,*
- *The below setup was done with an 1TB NTFS Mass Storage (the external drive should however be self powered by the power supply that came with the external drive).*




