


## **How to set up your DDNS account on your firewall**

To set up your DDNS account, click System → Misc. clients → Add and choose DynDnsClientDyndnsOrg. (Note that this firewall will not accept an account from **no-ip.com**)



Fill in your hostname, username and password for you DDNS account and click OK.
